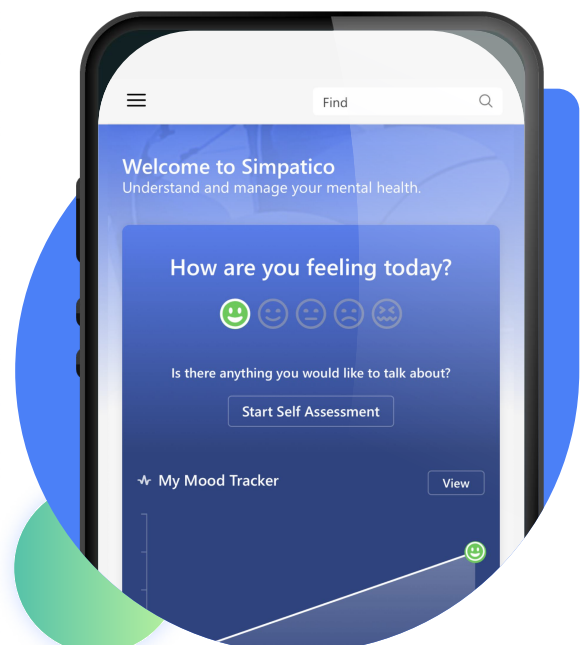
This foundational insight drives our use of AI to create a supportive, non-judgmental space for mental health discussions.

Our platform at a glance

-  **Conversational AI platform:** offers 24/7/365 access to diagnostic tools, support tips—and more—in an anonymous and secure manner
-  **Proprietary diagnostic engine:** empowers users to self-assess their mental health anonymously, with AI-driven support and relevant resources

Key areas of mental health support

Simpatico Ai provides support via anonymised and aggregated dashboard analytics, and actionable reports on the mental health state of an entire organisation. These insights are the outcome of depersonalised data collection and *provide granular detail around company-level mental wellness trends over time, including:*

- **Mood tracking** and monitoring of org-wide emotional states
- **Detection of mental health symptoms**, including severity of issues (based on a proprietary model developed by Chief Science Officer, Dr Kinsella, that assesses Intensity, Recency, Frequency and Severity of each symptom a user mentions)
- **Monitoring mental health workplace risk measures** such as Stress Levels, Satisfaction and Support
- **Employee support, tips and knowledge** via built-in Knowledge Hub
- **AI-generated summary reports** of the types of queries users generate anonymously as they interact with the 'Ask Simpatico' AI conversational engine and the mental health Knowledge Hub.

Enterprise-grade mental wellness platform

Following successful pilot trial programs of the Simpatico 'Mental Health Conversations Triage' framework, we identified the **key areas where Simpatico Ai can provide a new model for supporting mental health in today's companies:**



Allowing employees to engage in **private and confidential mental health conversations** that build trust between our Responsible AI and the end user. This is supported by psychoeducation material and tailored content for individual mental health challenges that has been curated and approved by experienced corporate and clinical psychologists. On the employer side, this ties in with tools that help to monitor and measure key compliance information for the psychosocial risk management mandates being rolled out across organisations.



The Simpatico Ai platform has been designed to leverage the existing staff support programs and wellness resources of an organisation, augmenting existing investments by guiding users to appropriate services and tools as well as providing easier access to and awareness of those resources.



This is all underpinned by the Simpatico **"safety net"** – the ability to be there any time, any place and listen to staff at their "moment of need", 24/7/365.

Content fed into the AI platform is curated by trained clinicians to ensure accuracy and evidence-based data and information.



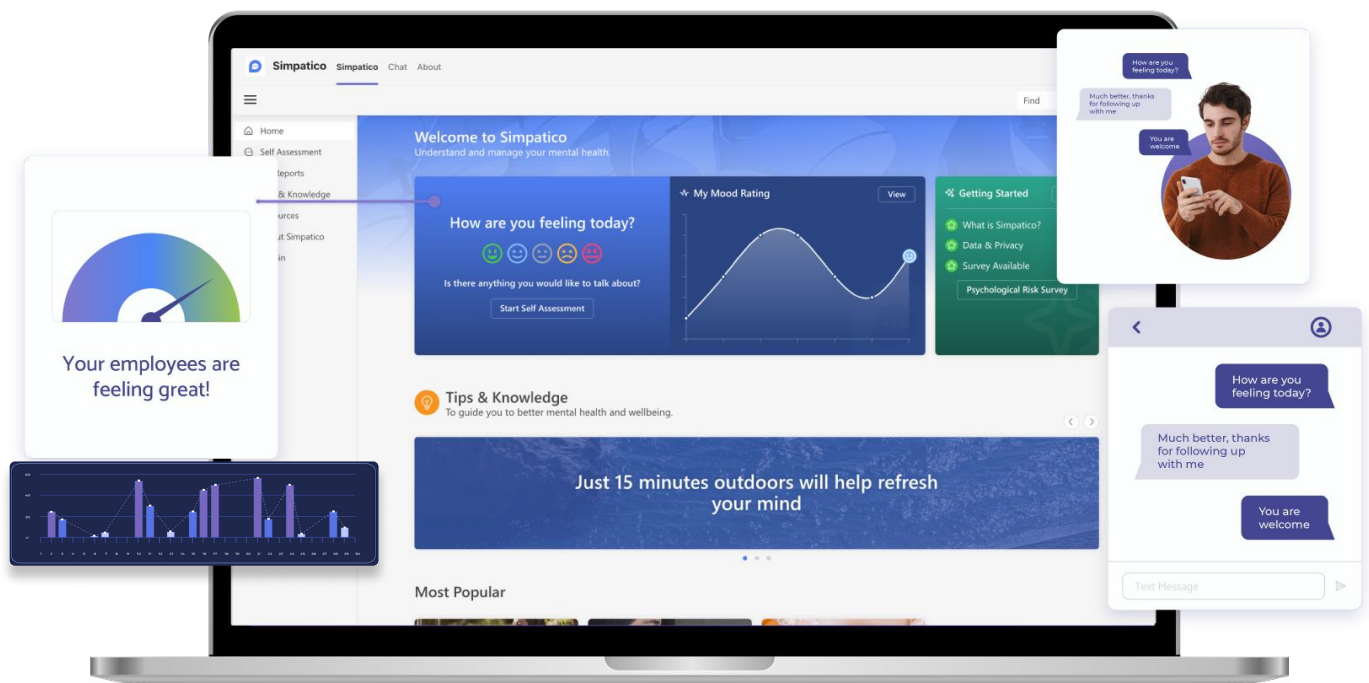
'Control' guardrails

Real-time mental wellness data is the future

One of the main issues is that only limited insights can be drawn from existing mental health corporate services due to the irregular nature of the data that is being gathered as part of these programs. Even if such data is being gathered regularly, it is generally not being fed back to leadership teams fast enough in order to make the appropriate management decisions - this is a key gap that Simpatico Ai addresses.



Most organisations surveyed by Simpatico Ai have little knowledge of what the actual prevalence of mental illness is in their workplace, except through very broad statistics such as the number of people on sick leave, the number of mental health or stress claims against submitted, or staff turnover. **Not having real-time insights will often have a pronounced negative impact on the culture of a business** as there is a direct link between the level of staff morale and company performance.

AI helps to tackle existing stigma around mental health

- 1 AI mental health applications combat stigma by providing a confidential and non-judgmental environment, encouraging open discussions and normalising mental health care
- 2 In general, there remains a lot of ignorance about what mental health problems are, and the benefits of early intervention. To this day Dr Kinsella has clients coming to him and saying things such as: "I've never seen a psychologist before because I thought mental illness was rubbish"
- 3 Employees fear the repercussions of engaging with employer-mandated programs, including most EAPs, and in some cases they have good cause for this. Research has proven that having an Ethical AI to interact with helps individuals to suspend their fears associated with therapy as they do not have to deal with another human who may judge them. As a result, they more openly bring up concerns that they would be likely to suppress in a traditional work setting.
